Worship-Sharing: Small groups meeting daily for deep sharing. Often, this is the most meaningful part of PYM. Those choosing week-long groups make a commitment to be there every day. Enter codes above:
 Traditional worship sharing - same group all week (WS), couples WS - same group all week (CPL), drop-in for those who cannot attend the full week (D), traditional meeting for worship for those who prefer it (MW). Children (CP) and teens (JYM) have worship as part of their programs.

Roommates: Enter preference for being housed with (M) men, (W) women, (X) mixed gender/family, (J) JYM, or (Y) Young Adult Friends. List specific roommates at right.

Children 0-5 years: Yes/no above. "Yes" means child needs a regular bed. "No" means child will sleep in a portable crib (provided by parent), in a sleeping bag on the floor, etc.

Note on Food: We ask Friends to help us remain in integrity by strictly complying with the rules to which we have agreed.

No outside food except baby formula may be consumed anywhere on Mt. Madonna Center property. (not even in your tent.)

Mt. Madonna serves simple vegetarian meals which include dairy but no eggs, fish, fowl, or meat.

Extra food maybe taken from the dining room to eat at another time. Snacks will be provided in the children and teen programs, and you may purchase snacks at the Mt. Madonna store.

Please do not bring any food or snacks from home. Dishes will be identified which contain gluten, wheat, soy, nuts, or dairy; however a list of every ingredient in each dish will not be available.

Mt. Madonna will try to accommodate other restrictions if communicated in advance. (although they cannot guarantee to meet all possible needs.)

Note 1: If commuting less than the full week, you may deduct 1/2 the daily fee for Mon and/or Sat.

Note 2: Paying adult in double/triple with shared bath whose only roommate is a child 5 years or under **pays the single rate.** (See 6d)

PREREGISTRATION

Everyone is required to preregister, except that Friends may attend only Meeting for Memorials without pre-registration or fee.

FOOD

Meals are not available for those only attending Meeting for Memorials. Food is otherwise included in the cost of both commuters and overnights. There is no option to exclude food. Please read note on page 1.

COMMUTERS

You may register for any number of commuter days (need not be consecutive). A commuter day includes breakfast, lunch, and supper on the day of attendance. Only supper is provided on Monday. Saturday meals consist of brunch and light snacks.

OVERNIGHT ATTENDERS

A full week is Monday evening through Saturday noon. You may register for the full week or for any number of **consecutive** nights. Three meals per day are included, starting with supper on the day of arrival and ending with lunch on the day of departure. Saturday meals consist of brunch and light snacks.

HOUSING

Options are camping, floor space on mats in large rooms, dormitories for 4-7 persons, semi-private rooms for 2-3 persons with shared bathrooms, or semi-private rooms for 2 persons with private bathrooms. Some semi-private rooms with shared bathrooms are in cabins constructed since PYM last met at Mt. Madonna. For dormitories or floor space, indicate whether you prefer to be housed with women, men, mixed gender/family groups, JYM, or YAF. Parents may opt to have older teens stay with the family or in separate, supervised girls and boys' sleeping areas. We hope that everyone will get their first choice of housing but need your second choice in case that is not possible. All who register **on or before May 21** will be considered at the same time when assigning housing.

BEDDING

Semi-private rooms and dormitories include sheets, pillows, and blankets. Floor space includes a sleeping mat but no bedding. **No housing option includes towels - please bring your own.**

EARLY DISCOUNT

The early discount is 5% of total fees (Line 4). This form, forms for minors, and check/money order for the total amount due (Line 7) must be postmarked **on or before May 21** to get the discount.

LATE REGISTRATIONS

There is a late fee of 5% of total fees (Line 4) if registration materials are postmarked **on or after July 2.**

Registrations on or after July 2 are subject to space availability.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations **on or before July 1** receive full refund. There is a \$100 fee for cancellations on or after July 2.

PAYMENT

You may enclose as little as 25% of the amount due (Line 7) and pay the balance upon arrival, but it is very helpful if you pay all fees in advance. You must pay the full amount due to get the early discount.
