Why are you interested in being a FAP?

Have you been a FAP before at Quarterly or Yearly Meeting? If so when?

Have you attended the “Being An Adult Ally to Teens Workshop” organized by the PYM Youth Program Coordinator? If so, tell us something you learned?

Have you worked with teens before? In what capacity?

Are you comfortable with setting boundaries and having to deal with discipline issues with teens? (JYM Clerks and Clerk of JYM Ministry and Oversight are first resources if they are still up.)

Are you interested in being a Day FAP (after breakfast to dinner time), or a Night FAP (after dinner to breakfast)? Hopefully Night FAPs will work all 5 nights but if you can only do part time please apply and state part time Night FAP. Full time in both categories will have priority because continuity is important.

If you are a Night FAP, are you prepared to be available all night in a living area where teens may be up late? FAPs will sleep in the same area as the teens; girls and boys will be in separate areas. They usually set a lights out time between one and two am.

Do you have any special needs, physical limitations, or requests?

Do you have other PYM responsibilities that might conflict? If so, what times are those scheduled?

Are you over 21?

Are you dating a JYMer?

For legal and insurance purposes we need to ask this question: Have you ever been accused or convicted of inappropriate behavior with a minor? If yes, please explain.

Have you had first aid training, CPR, or other? (There will be doctors & nurses available.)

Are you a parent of a youth attending this JYM?

Will you have a car at PYM? If so do you have a valid driver's license and insurance?
(Lack of a car will not prevent you from being a FAP.)

What are the names and phones number of two people we could we use as a references for your experience working with youth? Please state briefly their position and/or relationship to you in terms of your experience with youth.

*Please note that **PYM requires a background check** for all adults who spend significant time with teens.
