- 1- Read the Proposed Slate.

- 4- If you see blanks on the slate being presented, consider which service you could give, or help with, or whom you would recommend for the tasks, and get word to the Nominating Committee.

This was an interim appointment to be approved at this Annual Session. At this time, we do not have a name or names to bring forward for the position of Registrar for the 2024 term.
